Our accredited Before and After School Care Centre ('BAC' as we are more commonly known) caters for students from Kindergarten right through to Year 6.

We operate outside school hours as a service to parents/families whose work, study or family commitments extend beyond school hours.

Being in operation for 30 years, we pride ourselves in being a community based, non-profit Child Care Centre based within the grounds of Burraneer Bay Public School. At BAC we aim to work in partnership with our school, families and local community, to create fun and engaging programs, where everybody feels welcome and included.

It's exciting to still report that our 2023 newbies will benefit from more improvements, as we constantly strive to develop our practises to enrich children's lives.

Bookings & Fees:

Families are required to register with the Centre each year and children must be booked into the Centre prior to attending.

To enrol your child, you must complete an enrolment form and pay the appropriate registration fees.

* Children can be booked in permanently (the same day/s and session/s every week for the term), or alternatively on a casual basis (irregular or occasional days and sessions).

* BAC is an approved Child Care provider and Child Care Subsidy is therefore available as a reduction of fees. Please see the Co-ordinator for further details on this.

* Fees are payable via Direct Debit, fortnightly on a Thursday.

Re-registration \$20.00 (per family per year, half price if paid in Term 1)

Bond \$100.00 (once off payment and refundable at end of care)

Building Levy \$100.00 (once off payment, paid in 1st year of care)

BAC Educators are here to care and have fun through PLAY. If you have any questions about where to go or what to do, please ask one of the friendly educators in the BLUE shirt.

While at the service the children are always under the supervision of staff. Educator ratios are based on 1:15 or better (whilst at our centre).
